

# **1. Merit-Cum-Needs Scholarship for Girls**



## **Merit & Merit-Cum-Needs Scholarships**



#### <mark>Merit</mark>

- Open for all students
- Provided to 3% students at the top of their class
- Provided at 2 levels -
  - $\circ$  1% students get 100% fee
  - $\circ~~$  2% students gets 40% waiver

#### Merit-Cum-Needs

- Open only for students who have financial difficulty
- Provided to 27% meritorious students at 5 levels
- $\circ$   $\,$  3% students get 80% waiver
- $\circ~~6\%$  students gets 40% waiver
- $\circ$  12% students get 25% waiver
- $\circ$  6% students get 15% waiver
- Select Alumni Funded Scholarships are provided at 100%

### Women Scholarships Why Support Scholarships?

#### A. Diversity Perspective

- Women form only ~16% of the total First Degree Student population
- Only 10% students get scholarships at 80% tuition fee level under Merit Cum Needs (average over last 5 years)
- Current Tuition Fee is Rs. 4.92 Lacs, which may be high for women from families with financial difficulty

**IMPACT:** A scholarship for girl students will improve female representation in the batch.

#### **B. Ranking Perspective**

### In NIRF Rankings, we have the following parameters pertaining to Scholarships

B. Percentage of Women (Women Diversity WD): 30 marks

- WD =  $15 \times (N_{WS}/50) + 15 \times (N_{WF}/20)$
- $N_{WS}$  are the percentage of Women students.
- $\bullet \quad N_{WF} \text{ are the percentage of Women Faculty including women members in senior} \\ administrative positions, such as Heads of Departments, Deans or Institute Heads.$
- Expectation: 50% women students and 20% women faculty.
- C. Economically and Socially Challenged Students (ESCS) : 20 marks
  - ESCS =  $20 \times f(N_{esc})$
  - N<sub>esc</sub> is the percentage of UG or \*PG students being provided full tuition fee rembursement by the institution to pursue their degree programs.

**Total Marks:** 100, out of which 30 marks for gender diversity and 20 marks for full tuition fee scholarships

### Women Scholarships Proposed Budget – For 1 Female Student

# The Tuition amount for a 4 year program admitted in AY 2023-24 is ~Rs. 23 Lacs.

- To Cover 100% Scholarship amount for 1 student through an Endowment\* (interest), we would require an amount of Rs. 75 Lacs.
- You will have an option of donating 20 Lacs one time, for 1 student in reducing capital mode.





# **Faculty Awards at BITS**

**Overview** 

Currently, there are 3 Faculty Awards at BITS, instituted by Alumni as follows:

- 1. Prof. S Venkateshwaran Best Faculty Award: Given to 1 Faculty, a citation, and an award of Rs. 1 Lac every year. Set up by Karthik V of 1993 batch through a donation of the award amount every year
- 2. Dr. CR Mitra Best Faculty Award : Given to 1 Faculty, a citation, and an award of Rs. 1 Lac every year. Set up by Prof. V S Rao, former vice-chancellor and Director of BITS Pilani, through a donation of the award amount every year
- **3. Prof. SSR Memorial Best Faculty Award**: Given to 1 Faculty, a citation, and an award of Rs. 1 Lac every year. Set up by N S Parthasarthy, 1978 Batch through and endowment of Rs. 25 Lacs

### Faculty Awards at BITS Assessment

#### Broadly, the awards committee look at the following criteria before making a decision:

- Innovation in Instruction (creative methods/courses which enhanced the students' understanding and learning)
- Contribution to Research
- Professional Achievement (publications, projects, committee membership etc.)
- Contributions to BITS Pilani (involvement in activities outside the classroom)
- Commitment to student success (success of students in his/her courses, involvement of students in his/her projects/publications)
- Contributions towards neighborhood societal development

### Faculty Awards at BITS Budget

We propose setting up an award exclusively for women faculty members at BITS. We recommend that it may be done as follows:

Donation Amount in Reducing Capital Mode: Rs. 32 Lacs Award Amount: Rs. 2 Lacs No. of Awards: 2 No. of Years your fund can award the Faculty: 10 Years Total No. of Faculty Awarded: 20

Award could be on 1 young professor (Assistant or Associate level) and 1 seasoned professor (Prof. or Senior Prof. level) across BITS campuses





### **Sewage Treatment Plant at Pilani Town**



**BITS** Pilani

 Pilani is a small town, and a home to Birla Institute of Technology & Science. Close to 14,000 people live in this town, without a Sewage Treatment Plant (STP). Along with the local government, we propose setting up a nature based treatment system i.e. a vertical flow constructed wetlands for the treatment of Sewage that is generated in the city, and which currently flows through open nallahs, untreated.





• The solution has been designed by Prof. Srikanth Mutnuri, who has received grants for this solution from Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and Biotechnology Industrial Research and Council, Government of India. The same solution has been installed at Bogmalo Beach, Goa and In BITS Pilani K.K. Birla Goa Campus.

The total cost of the Project is Rs. 4 Cr. or a similar amount in US Dollars. A scaled down version of this project would cost Rs. 1.5 – Rs. 2 Cr. The Municipality will acknowledge the naming and further maintenance.

# **Pilani Convention Centre - Overview**

#### PROPOSAL

Build a state-of-the-art convention center with residential facilities at Pilani campus with Alumni Funding. It will have 92 rooms on 5-levels, with modern outlook and amenities

#### **WHY PILANI CONVENTION CENTRE?**

At present, BITS is constrained by lack of modern convention centre and residential facilities to host large number of visitors, and thus unable to host large conferences



#### **UTILITY AND USAGE**

Can host multiple conferences, development programs and alumni reunions, thus building the brand and additional revenue stream.



#### **CURRENT PROJECT STAGE**

Architect Hafeez Contractor is preparing the structural design, post which necessary regulatory approvals shall be sought; Total Project Cost Estimate: ~Rs.30 Cr.

### **About the Facilities – Pilani Convention Centre**

**Pilani Convention Centre**: Would be a 92 room facility with a conference room and a dining area. It would be used for hosting alumni reunions, conferences, and executive training programs. Total area would be ~55,000 Sq. ft.

There will be 3 blocks in the Pilani Convention Centre:

- Conference Room and Dining Areas (2 Level)
- Residential Building 1 (G+4 Levels): 46 rooms (~9 Rooms per floor with two wings of 4 and 5 rooms)
- Residential Building 2 (G+4 Levels): 46 rooms (~9 Rooms per floor with two wings of 4 and 5 rooms)



# **Pilani Convention Centre – Funding Options**

New Guest House to be built entirely from alumni support. Alumni may choose to support from the following options

- Single Room: Rs. 15 Lacs
- A Wing of 4 Rooms: Rs. 45 Lacs
- A Wing of 5 Rooms: Rs. 60 Lacs
- A Floor: Rs. 1 Cr.
- A Residential Block: Rs. 4 Cr.
- Custom Donation for any element of the Convention Centre is also possible.
