- 1. Exceptional quality of publications (in terms of Citation, Impact Factor, Reputation etc.).
- 2. Innovative Teaching Pedagogy introduced
- 3. Prestigious national awards
- 4. Lab Development



- 5. New courses introduced
- 6. Fellowship of National Academies or Eminent International bodies (e.g. IEEE, ASME, ASCE, etc.).
- 7. Membership of Editorial Boards / Reviewers of reputed indexed journals.
- 8. Distinguished achievements in innovation, incubation and entrepreneurship
