The role would require a person to be extremely organized and diligent on documentation and communication with the donors. Principal Accountabilities & Responsibilities	 Lead and manage key flagship engagement initiatives Identify and cultivate new engagement opportunities for alumni to participate Manage and de-bottleneck the engagement initiatives Work with internal teams to ensure timely progress in the projects supported by the donors, and escalation if necessary Prepare and present progress and utilization reports on a periodical basis to each of the donors Maintain consistent communication (monthly calls, quarterly reporting etc.) with donors of BITS, and act as a one-stop source of information
