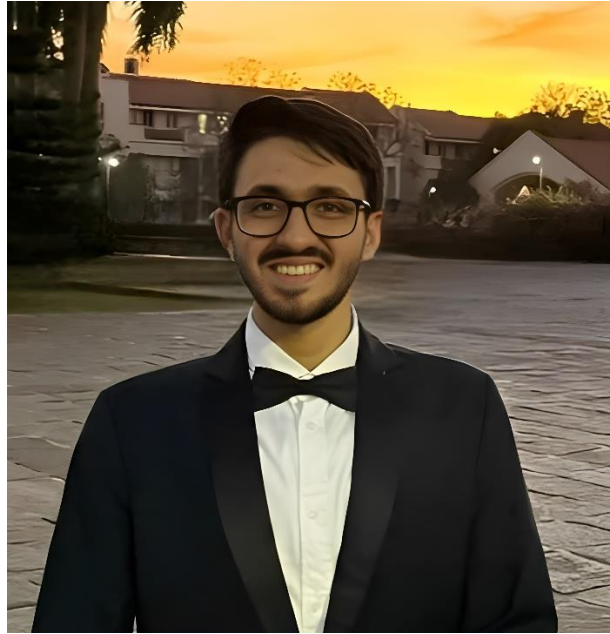
Brief Profile of Mantra Awardees (2023-2024) at BITS Pilani K K Birla Goa Campus

1. Kartik Anand (Mantra Award for Outstanding Leadership - Male)

In the academic year 2022-2023, he served as the Treasurer of the Council of Student Affairs (CSA), representing a cohort of over 3500 students. Throughout his tenure, Anand managed an extensive budget of 3.25 crore, which encompassed three fests, 25 clubs, and 14 departments. Notably, his initiatives played a pivotal role in revitalizing the campus culture post-COVID-19, particularly through the allocation of substantial funds for club activities. Anand also spearheaded the administration of the Student Aid fund, a crucial financial assistance program based on need. Under his leadership, the Council successfully advocated for the installation of ten vending machines on campus. Prior to his role as Treasurer, Anand served as the Secretary of the Department of Economics and Finance, where he facilitated communication between students and faculty members. Beyond his academic and administrative endeavors, Anand demonstrates a profound passion for sports, having captained his school basketball team and maintaining a keen interest in the game. His evolving perspective on leadership underscores the belief that true leaders prioritize the broader vision and navigate uncharted paths with conviction, a philosophy he has consistently applied across various leadership roles.
