

Dr. Dhongdi to research on underwater communication

A faculty member in the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering at BITS Pilani, K K Birla Goa Campus, Dr. Sarang Dhongdi has been selected by the French Institute in India (IFI) for their SSHN programme. This programme supports research trips between India and France to strengthen collaboration.



Dhongdi will visit the DYNILab (Université de Toulon, Aix Marseille Univ, CNRS, LIS) as a Visiting Scholar in September 2024. His research will focus on underwater acoustic communication and networking. His work may also

contribute to the curriculum of the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master's Degree in Marine and Maritime Intelligent Robotics (MIR) by proposing projects on underwater UAV networking and communications. Recently, Dr. Sarang, along with researchers from CSIR-NIO and NIT Calicut, received a project under the Ministry of Earth Sciences' Deep Ocean Mission (MOES) to study deep-sea plumes.
