## BITS Pilani Goa wins RBI90Quiz

The team from Birla Institute of Technology and Science (BITS), Pilani, Goa campus, has emerged winner in the state-level round of RBI90Quiz, a nationwide general knowledge-based quiz competition for undergraduate students launched by Reserve Bank of India (RBI) as part of its 90th anniversary celebrations. Forty-four teams from educational institutes in Goa took part in the state-level competition held at the Convention Centre, Panaji, on October 10. Each team comprises two students.

The BITS Pilani team comprising Dhruv Chandak and Ketav Shah emerged as the winner, followed by the teams from Goa College of Engineering, Farmagudi, and Shree Rayeshwar Institute of Engineering and Information Technology, Shiroda in second and third places, respectively. Prizes for the top three teams are Rs 2 lakh, Rs 1.5 lakh, and Rs 1 lakh, respectively.

The winning team will now compete in the zonal round, which will take place between November 21, and December 4. The national finale will be held in Mumbai in December. The first, second, and third prize winners in the zonal round will be awarded Rs 5 lakh, Rs 4 lakh and Rs 3 lakh respectively, while the top three teams in the national finale will be given Rs 10 lakh, Rs 8 lakh, and Rs 6 lakh.
