epartment of Chemistry of BITS Pilani, KK Birla Goa Campus, through a MoU, became an Associate Partner of the prestigious 17th Century University of Tartu, Estonia (a country in Northern Europe) for an international two-year joint master degree programme 'Excellence in Analytical Chemistry (EACH)'.

This EACH programme is funded by the Education, Audio-visual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) of the Commission of the European Communities (the European Commission) under the Erasmus+ Framework programme. This programme educates specialists in analytical chemistry well qualified to work in the industry (such as food, pharmaceutical, materials, energy, etc.) and chemical analysis laboratories worldwide. 'EACH' programme provides knowledge and skills in both fundamental and applied aspects of modern analytical chemistry.

Recently the University of Tartu invited Prof Narendra Nath Ghosh, professor of Chemistry at BITS Pilani, Goa Campus with a Visiting Scholar Award to teach there in the EACH programme. During his visit, Prof Ghosh taught a course on Nanoscience and Nanotechnology, and its application in Analytical Chemistry.
