Lamani successfully completed his research thesis titled 'A Study of Morphological and Motor Fitness of Junior and Senior Cricket Players of Goa' under the guidance of Pratap Singh Tiwari. Tiwari is the former Vice-Chancellor, Gulbarga University and Director of Sports, Government of Karnataka in the Research Department of Physical Education and Sports Sci-

ence of Karnatak University, Dharwad.

Lamani is the second Goan cricket player to complete the doctorate degree in Physical Education and Sports Science.
