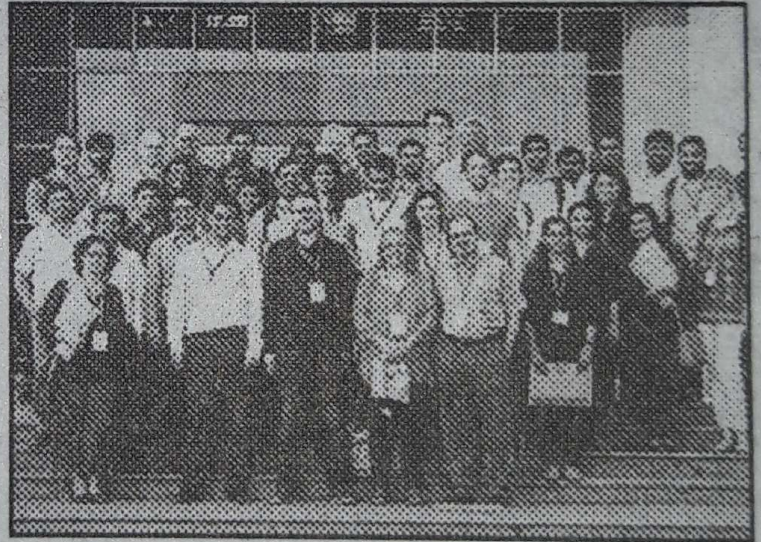


# **BITS Pilani, Zuarinagar**
